Finance Minister welcomes AL JAMA-AH's Member of Parliament proposals on an interest free State Bank for South Africa

Finance Minister Tito Mboweni responded positively to AL JAMA-AH's Member of Parliament Hon. Ganief Hendrick's call for the establishment of an interest free State Bank in South Africa and the embracing of the 4th Industrial Revolution. Hon Hendricks was debating in the National Plenary session in Parliament on Wednesday 10 March 2021 on Consideration of Fiscal Framework and Revenue Proposals, 2021.
