## AL JAMA-AH CALLS ON PRESIDENT CYRIL RAMAPHOSA TO DEPLOY SANDF

This is a very sad day in Cape Town we have seen the damage that has been created by the fire that continues to rage in Cape Town. The Al Jama-ah party calls on President Cyril Ramaphosa to deploy the SANDF urgently to the affected areas.

Beyond the damage to property, 4000 students of UCT have been displaced and as the fire rages on more homes, families and animals are displaced and impacted in several areas. The existing forces and volunteers are not enough to bring the raging fire under control. Firefighters have been fighting this blaze around the clock since 9am yesterday morning.
