Member of Parliament's online streaming interactive radio station - Taking Parliament to the People

Honourable Ganief Hendricks, Member of Parliament is moving a step ahead to ensure that South Africans are regularly updated with Parliamentary debates. He is in the process of launching an online streaming interactive radio station, "Taking Parliament to the People."

Hendricks, who has the full support of his party Al Jama-ah, says the online radio will have its own new approach on how to disseminate the various dialogues taking place inside Parliament to the people.
