As the party is awaiting the results from the Electoral Court, it wishes to place on record that we are confident in our preparation for the by-election in Ward 63 which encompasses the area of Ottery, Plumstead and Wynberg.

Parties were informed by the Provincial Electoral Officer in the Western Cape that the Electoral Commission has resolved to approach the Electoral Court to request that the by-elections scheduled for 30 June 2021 be postponed in view of the adjusted alert level 4 of the lockdown.

Al Jama-ah feels the by-election should take place as it is not a political gathering or rally. All Covid protocols are in place and the move to adjusted Level 4 should not affect the election at all.
