## Al Jama-ah welcomes the IEC's announcement on 2021 Municipal Elections

The AI Jama-ah party has welcomed the Independent Electoral Commission's (IEC) announcement that it will reopen the candidate registration list ahead of the looming municipal election.

The IEC confirmed on Monday that local government elections will be held on 1 November 2021.

Party Leader Mr. Ganief Hedricks says "Al Jama-ah congratulates the IEC for rising to the occasion to ensure that there are free and fair elections; by opening candidate's nomination and that the democratic order prevails. It cannot be that if a mayor is elected, more than half of his/her voters did not have an opportunity to vote for the party and the candidate of their choice".

Al Jama-ah's vibrant social media platforms will be used and accelerate in the build up to elections. The party's candidates will be profiled on these platforms, and these will also be used for communications purpose.

Al Jama-ah encourages their supporters to register on the weekend of 18 and 19 September.

Local government elections give communities a chance to vote for the people who they believe will best represent the concerns and solutions within their ward and ensure their service delivery interests such as water and electricity; the maintenance of parks, roads, and other public spaces; the implementation of housing projects drawn up by national and provincial governments.
