**Al Jama-ah talks with ANC includes fast tracking restitution for District 6 Group Areas Act victims**

The Al Jama-ah party held a high-level meeting with members of the ANC's NEC (National Executive Committee) to discuss common principles and policies to speed up service delivery to South Africans.

The Al Jama-ah leader and Member of Parliament Hon. Ganief Hendricks was accompanied by the party's Gauteng Provincial Chairperson, Thapelo Amad and the ANC's NEC members were led by Jeff Radebe accompanied by a member of the PEC Gauteng Provincial Committee, MEC Panyaza Lesufi and Thoko Didiza in Johannesburg recently.

- Uninterrupted water supply to Municipalities like in Harding, Mathubatuba and Braemar in Umdoni and
- That Al Jama-ah will support the ANC's programmes and projects in Tswane and Ekhurleni.
