AL JAMA-AH Member of Parliament appointed to Pan African Parliament Focus Group

The Al Jama-ah party's leader and Member of Parliament (MP) Hon Ganief Hendricks has been appointed to serve on the Pan African Parliament Focus Group, a sub structure of the Parliamentary Group on International Relations (PGIR).
